O Christ my King, enthroned in glory and present in the Blessed Sacrament, I come to adore You with all my heart.



Words of St. Francis of Assisi in his Letter to the Entire Order, 26-28

Let everyone be struck with fear, let the whole world tremble, and let the heavens exult when Christ, the Son of the living God, is present on the altar in the hands of the priest!

O admirable heights and sublime humility! O humble sublimity! The Lord of the universe, God and the Son of God, so humbles Himself that for our salvation He hides Himself under a little form of bread!

Look, brothers, at the humility of God, and pour out your hearts before Him! Humble yourselves that you may be exalted by Him! Therefore, keep nothing of yourselves for yourselves, that He Who gives Himself totally to you may receive you totally!

- We need to ensure there are people praying in the Church for the whole period of the Three Days.
- Please sign the list in the porch, to show the half hour or more when you will watch and pray in the Church.
- Individuals, parish groups and organisations, and our parish primary schools are invited to pledge to pray for a period in church.
