Today's Bible Readings

In the Old Testament reading, Moses reminded the people of Israel he had been the one who on their behalf had encountered God's awe-inspiring holiness on Mount Horeb (Sinai), had heard his majestic voice and looked upon the fire that emanated from his presence. God promises Moses, 'I will raise up a prophet like yourself for them from their own brothers — I will put my words into his mouth.' This promise is fulfilled with the coming of Christ.

In the Gospel, we hear how he preaches in the Capernaum synagogue, which makes a deep impression on the people as he teaches them with authority. They say' Here is a teaching is new, and with authority behind it.' Even the unclean spirit whom Jesus drives out of a possessed man recognises him as the Holy One of God. Jesus' reputation spreads rapidly throughout Galilee.

Today is the Day of Prayer for Racial Justice. This year's theme is "Seeing One Another in the Life of the Church," celebrating the diversity of those who have led holy and exemplary lives.
