Today is the Feast of the Anniversary of Dedication of the Lateran Basilica - the Church in Rome where Pope Leo has his Chair as the Bishop of Rome. It is called the Mother and Head of all the Churches of the City and the World.

Today's Bible Readings

In the First Reading, the Prophet Ezekiel has a vision of living water flowing out from the side of the temple in Jerusalem, which became a great river and caused everything to live wherever it flowed. On its banks were trees constantly bearing fruit.

In the second reading, St Paul tells the Corinthian Christians that they are God's building, of which he laid the foundation, which is Christ. This building is a holy temple of God, in which the Holy Spirit dwells

In the Gospel Jesus cleanses the temple in Jerusalem, which he calls 'My Father's house,' by clearing out the traders who are desecrating it. He foretells that his own body will become the true temple: it will be destroyed in death, but raised up on the third day.

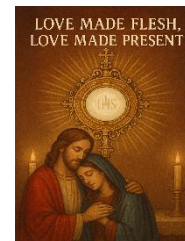
Today at 10.00 am: Enrolment Mass of those children and their families who have been accepted onto the First Communion Programme this year.
