Today's Bible Readings

In the First Reading the prophet Zephaniah urges the people of Israel returning from Exile to seek the Lord in humility and lowliness, to do no injustice and to speak no lies. Then they need have no fear.

In the Second Reading St Paul reminds his converts that not many of them were wise or powerful by worldly standards, because God has chosen what is foolish or weak to shame the wise and the strong. They are in Christ, who himself is God's wisdom, righteousness, sanctification and redemption.

In the Gospel we read the eight Beatitudes proclaimed by Jesus at the beginning of his Sermon on the Mount as a kind of crystallisation of everything that he will go on to teach. The kingdom of heaven will belong to those who are poor in spirit, meek, merciful, who seek righteousness, and are peacemakers, who are falsely denounced on

account of Christ. Their reward will be great in heaven, where the pure in heart will see God.

The Epiphany Crib remains in the Church until tomorrow, Candlemas, 2nd February. Crib offerings go to support the work of the Catholic Children's Society in our Diocese of Westminster, and are the main annual source of the Society's income.

Monday 2nd February is the Presentation of the Lord, Candlemas. It celebrates the infant Jesus being presented in the Temple at the age of 40 days, where he was recognised as the Light of the Nations and the Glory of Israel. Solemn Mass at 6.00 pm, which begins with the Blessing and Procession of Candles.

On Tuesday 3rd February, we will celebrate the Feast of St Blaise at Mass. At the end of the liturgy, the traditional Blessing of Throats will be given, asking God's protection and healing through the intercession of this saint, especially for illnesses of the throat. All are warmly invited to attend and receive this blessing.

On Thursday 5th February, at 5.30 pm, His Eminence Cardinal Vincent Nichols will celebrate in Westminster Cathedral a Solemn Pontifical Mass in thanksgiving for 16 years as Archbishop of Westminster. All are most welcome to attend.

Our children preparing for First Communion celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation this Saturday morning 7th February. Please pray for them and their families.

An Appeal for the work of Mary's Meals will be made at all Sunday Masses 14th /15th February, with a collection at the end of Mass.

Parish Readers: Last week we celebrated the Sunday of the Word of God: The Blessing of our Parish Readers took place at all Masses. We are hoping to recruit some new readers to augment our rota.
