Today's Bible Readings

In the first reading from Genesis, the fall into original sin is described. Immediately the harmony between God and man, human beings themselves, and man and the created world, is spoiled. But already there is the first announcement of the Gospel of Redemption. The promise that the offspring of the Woman will crush the serpent's head is eventually fulfilled in Jesus, the Son of Mary.

In the second reading, St Paul explains that God who raised the Lord Jesus to life, will raise us with him in our turn. When the tent of our earthly life is folded up, God will build us an everlasting house in the heavens. Therefore our sights are set on eternity rather than on this world.

In the Gospel, Jesus in his description of someone who breaks into a house and ties up the strong man so he can burgle his property, is really prophesying his own raiding of Satan's kingdom through his death and resurrection, so freeing us from the evil one's power.

Welcome to all the children who celebrate the Thanksgiving Mass for their First Holy Communion at 10.00am today. It will be a Mass of the Holy Eucharist, and special Bible readings will be used, not in our Sunday Missal. Children sit in the front dressed in their First Holy Communion outfits with their families behind them. Mass concludes with a short Benediction followed by a party for the children in the parish centre.

Next weekend our Collection of Non-Perishable Foodstuffs for the Hammersmith & Fulham Foodbank will take place on Saturday evening **15th/Sunday 16th June**. Specially needed are coffee, jam, biscuits and shower gel. The need for help from the foodbank is ever-increasing, so we will try to increase our support!
