Today's Bible Readings

In the First Reading the tribes of Israel remember God's words that David is to be shepherd of his people Israel and their prince. Therefore they come to him at Hebron, where David makes a covenant with them, and they anoint him King over Israel.

In the Second Reading St Paul gives thanks that his converts have been delivered from the domain of darkness and transferred to the kingdom of God's beloved Son, who has made peace with God by the blood of his cross.

In the Gospel the soldiers mock Jesus on his cross due to the inscription over it, 'This is the King of the Jews.' One of the two thieves also crucified join in their mockery, but the other thief says, 'Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom.'

Thank you to those who prepared for our Three Days of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament which have just taken place: our MC & servers, our church cleaners, our

flower arranger, our Family Mass choir, those who led group or school class visits, everyone who came to pray, and our caterers for the Saturday evening party.
