Fr Juan writes: THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

Breaking News! Good News! We can drop an old faulty mind-set! God is not an "old and powerful bachelor!" God is a community of people. God is a family—a communion of persons in a relationship of love.

Not a toxic relationship. Not a virtual relationship. Not an artificial relationship. Not a financially beneficial relationship. Not a relationship of need. But a relationship of giving, of self-giving love. Liberating, self-transcending, a relationship in the truth that does not judge, a patient relationship, an allowing and forgiving relationship, a fruitful relationship.

Our God is not a self-isolating being and we are created after his signature. He has created us in his own image. Let us enter, therefore, the life of this heavenly community through the community of the Church that mirrors it. A common-unity that can truly begin to produce life, peace, and joy amongst us. The Trinity is not a theory to understand, but a life to enter.

There are a number of symbols of the Blessed Trinity in our Church. See if you can find these, (and perhaps others!) Sculpted above the outside of the main door: the shield of the Holy Trinity. Painted above the inside door of the side porch: The Throne of Mercy. Depicted in the stained glass window above the west gallery: the three Persons of the Holy Trinity.
