Today's Bible Readings:

The prophet Daniel in the Old Testament prophesies the coming of the Son of Man on whom will be conferred Sovereignty, glory and kingship. The New Testament reading from the Apocalypse shows how this has come true in Christ, who will come in glory at the end of time to reveal his now hidden kingship. Already he has washed away our sins through his blood, enabling us to share his kingship and his priesthood, so that we can serve his God and Father. In the Gospel, at his trial, which will end in his redemptive death on the cross, Jesus affirms in answer to Pilate's question that the truth is that he is indeed a King, although not in the usual worldly sense and that he was born into the world to bear witness to this.

This Saturday, 19th November is the third and final day of our Three Days of Eucharistic Adoration, 'This is our God, the Servant King', which concludes with Benediction at 5.30 pm, and Sung Mass of Christ the King, at 6.00 pm, at which Archbishop Emeritus Kevin McDonald of Southwark, is the main celebrant. After Mass, all are invited to drinks and light refreshments in the Parish Centre. Thank you to all who have helped us keep this special period of prayer, by cleaning and beautifying the church, by preparing the altar and sanctuary and maintaining the continuous blaze of candles, by making the flower arrangements, by leading the public devotions and times of prayer for children and young people - all of which have helped us to pray, and to recognise the presence of our God, the Servant King, in the Blessed Sacrament.

Each week of November there will be Requiem Masses offered for the Holy Souls, this week on Wednesday.
