VATICAN II – GUIDING STAR

In 2025 we kept the 60th Anniversary of the Second Vatican Council, which was a General Council of the church, in which all the Bishops of the Catholic world took part, 1962-1965. Its four main documents, ('Constitutions'), began a great movement of renewal in the Catholic Church. Pope Leo is currently giving a series of General Audience addresses on these documents. He invites us to reread and reflect upon them, since as he says 'Vatican II still constitutes the guiding star of the Church's journey today' Our four Lent Talks give us the opportunity to do so.

Rosary: Tuesday after 6.00 pm Mass.

Divine Mercy Prayers: Thursday after 9.00am Mass

a sign of sorrow for our sin and our willingness to turn back to God

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are Days of Fast (one main meal and one snack only) and Abstinence (from meat)
Every Friday is a Day of Abstinence (from meat.)

We should also choose our own form of self-denial. Money saved from it can be for:

- Our Almsgiving,
is a sign of our gratitude for God's mercy by showing mercy to others.
