

Today's Bible Readings

The Gospel anticipates Advent, starting in two weeks, as Jesus invites his disciples to look ahead to the future. Before Christ comes again in glory there will be natural disasters, plagues, wars and revolutions. They must expect persecution for witnessing to him, but by their endurance they will gain their lives. In the first reading Malachi prophesies that for those who fear God's name the sun of righteousness will rise with healing in its wings.

Today: the Annual Collection for the Sick and Retired Priests' Fund of our Diocese takes place after all Masses. Last year, the Diocese of Westminster provided care to 73 retired priests, at a cost of £1,270,000. Using a donation envelope enables you to gift aid.
