The policy of the Catholic Church both in England and Wales is to report every allegation of abuse to statutory authorities. It includes abuse which has occurred in the past, or recently as well as whether the accused person is alive or deceased.

Everyone who has a role in the Catholic Church in England and Wales must refer allegations to the safeguarding office for the Diocese/religious congregation or directly to the police.

Members of the public should refer allegations directly to the police and the safeguarding office in your Diocese.
